

# TOWN OF NORTH RIVER

## RECYCLING GUIDELINES

The Town of North River will commence our recycling program on Wednesday, July 3, 2019. Recycled materials will be picked up **once every two weeks on the same day as your regular garbage collection.**

### Materials Accepted

#### CONTAINERS

- Aluminum Cans/Trays (e.g. pop and beer cans, pie plates, baking trays)
- Plastic Bottles (e.g. water, pop, liquor)
- Plastic Containers (e.g., bleach, liquid laundry detergent, shampoo, liquid soap, mouthwash, contact lens solution, butter, sour cream, household cleaners, windshield wash bottles, salad dressing, ice cream, ketchup yogurt etc.)
- Tin Cans (e.g. soup, coffee, tuna, cat food etc.)
- Milk & Juice Cartons
- Tetra Paks (e.g. juice boxes, soup etc.)



#### Paper Products

- Newspapers, Flyers, & Junk Mail
- Magazines, Catalogues & Phone Books
- Envelopes (not bubbled or insulated envelopes)
- Writing & Computer Paper (e.g. lined, white, coloured)
- Books (remove hardcovers)
- Boxboard (e.g. cereal, cracker, frozen food, tissue, detergent boxes & more)
- Egg Cartons (the cardboard kind)
- Take Out Drink Trays
- Paper Bags
- Toilet Paper Rolls & Paper Towel Rolls
- Corrugated Cardboard



## Materials NOT Accepted

These items must stay **out** of the clear bags.

- Aerosol & Paint Cans
- Diapers
- Drink/Coffee Cups
- Gift Wrapping Paper
- Kitty Litter
- Plastic Bags/Wrap
- Styrofoam
- Syringes



## Special Materials

### Glass

Glass beverage containers are excluded from recycling. We have an account set up at the Green Depot in Bay Roberts in the name of the Town of North River and all proceeds will go to our recreation program.

### Bulk Items

Bulk items that were traditionally picked up, i.e. mattresses, fridges, washers, etc. These items will continue to be picked up on regular garage day.

# How to Recycle

## 1 SORT IT

### Sort It

- Sort recyclables into two groups: Containers and Paper Products.
- Make sure everything's clean. Rinse food containers so there's no food left inside, especially milk containers.
- Remove lids and caps from your containers, and remove wrap from boxes and paper.

## 2 BAG IT



### Bag It

- Place paper products and containers into separate clear bags. We can only take recyclables that are not mixed together.
- Use only clear plastic bags which can be bought at most retail stores where you buy your regular garbage bags.
- Place recyclables loosely in the clear bag. Do not put recyclables in grocery store bags and then into clear bags. Grocery store bags are not recyclable but clear bags are.
- The clear bags that you put your recyclables in will also be recycled.

### Curb It

- Place your separated clear bags with your garage on recycling day which is every second week commencing on July 3, 2019.
